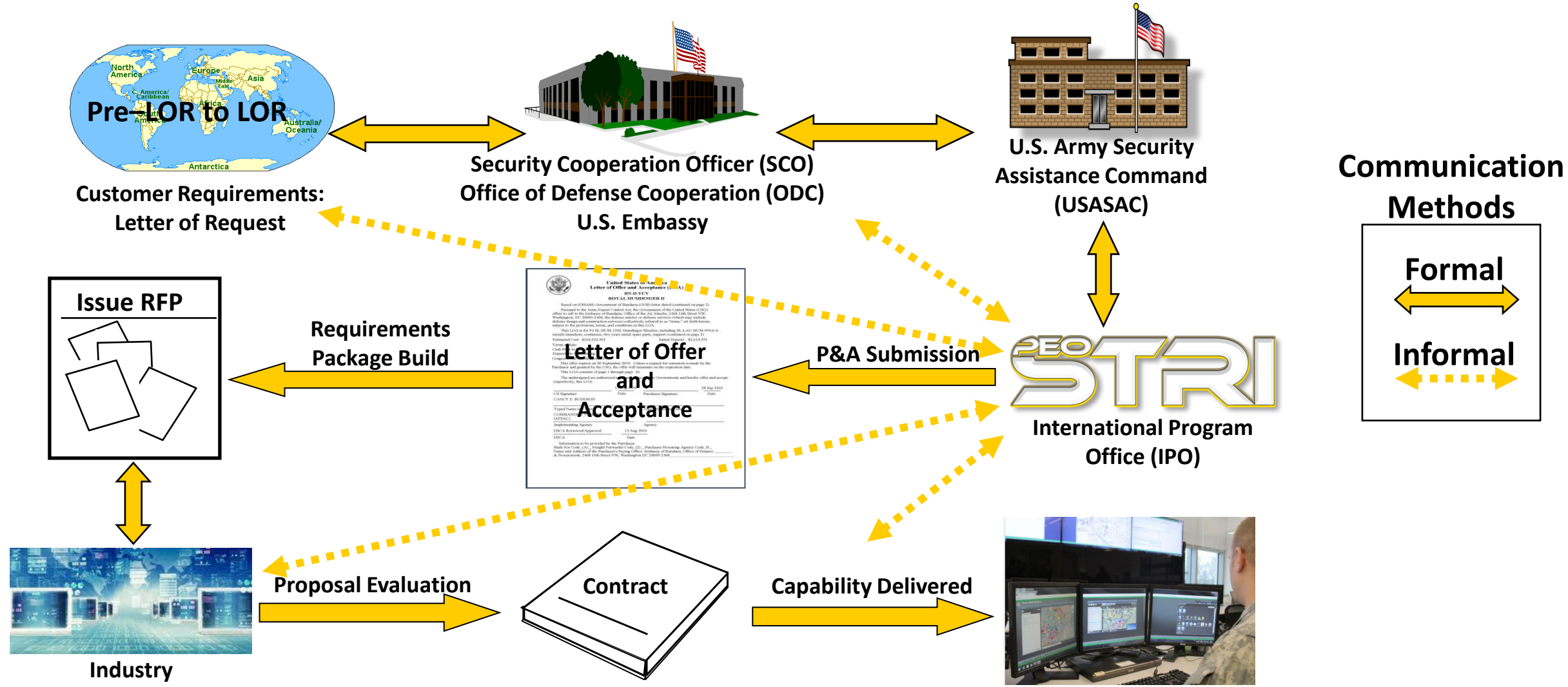

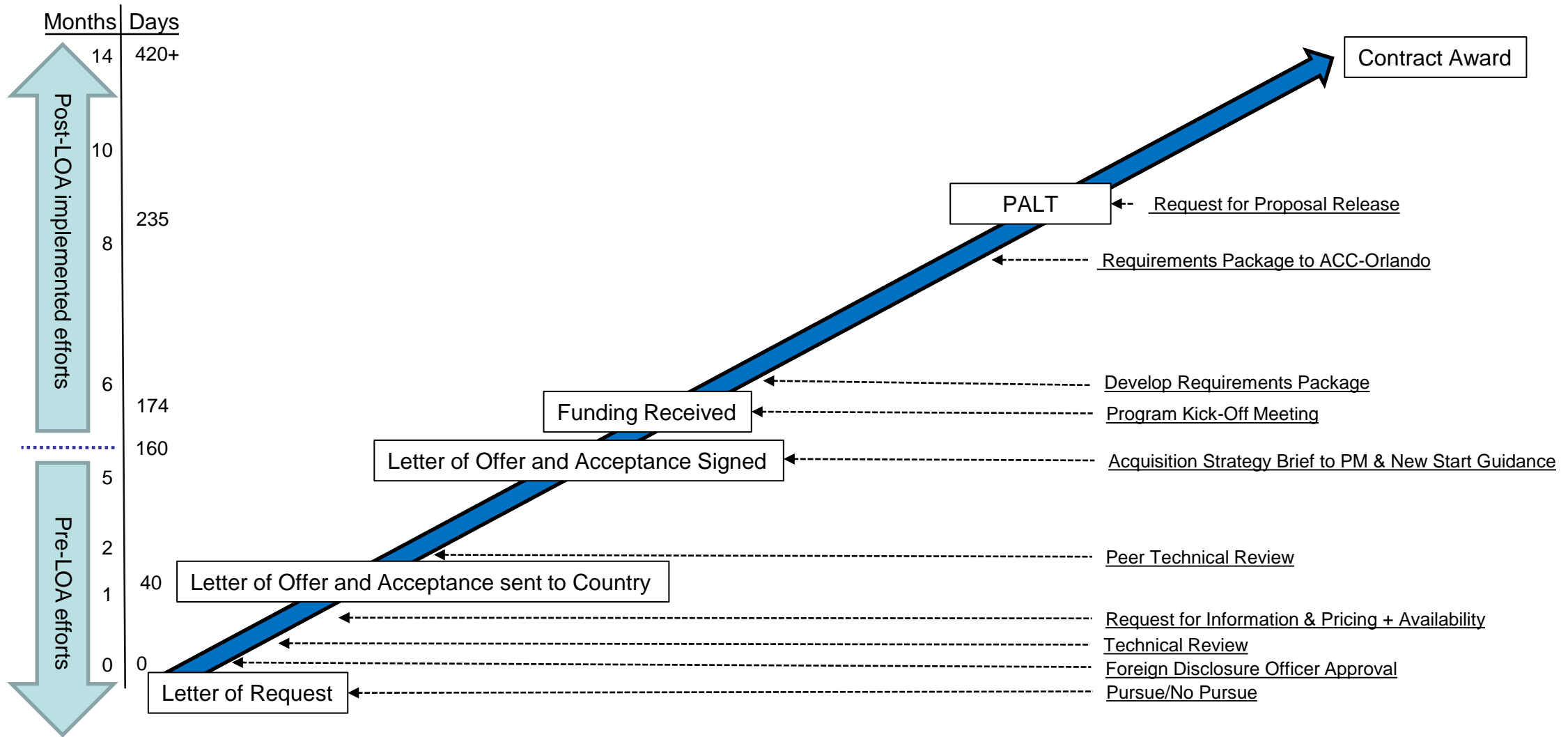


Foreign Military Sales Process and Communication
